

## **RESOLUTION NO. 7970**

### **RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BOULDER CITY, NEVADA, APPROVING AGREEMENT NO. 25-033 BETWEEN THE CITY OF BOULDER CITY AND CITY OF HENDERSON TO PROVIDE FOR DEDICATION OF PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY AND DELINEATING ROADWAY IMPROVEMENT AND MAINTENANCE RESPONSIBILITIES FOR RIGHTS-OF-WAY ALONG EXISTING ROADWAY COMMONLY KNOWN AS SILVERLINE ROAD**

**WHEREAS,** Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 277.180 authorize public agencies to enter into interlocal agreements to jointly perform any governmental service or undertaking that they are each legally authorized to perform; and

**WHEREAS,** the City Henderson has annexed land adjacent to the Boulder City limits in the Eldorado Valley and intends to develop roadways to improve regional transportation connectivity; and

**WHEREAS,** the City of Boulder City owns property within the Eldorado Valley containing existing roadways and alignments, including Silverline Road; and

**WHEREAS,** the Cities of Boulder City and Henderson have negotiated two interlocal agreements to support regional roadway connectivity in the Eldorado Valley; and

**WHEREAS,** pursuant to Agreement No. 25-033, the City of Boulder City will continue to perpetuate the use of Silverline Road ("Silverline") from US 95 westward to the boundary between Assessor's Parcel No. 189-11-501-001 and No. 189-12-301-001, located in Boulder City, and Assessor's Parcel No. 189-11-701-001, located in Henderson; and

**WHEREAS,** the City of Henderson will make one-time improvements to Silverline consisting of a "chip and seal" project, at its sole cost and expense, in association with the Nevada Department of Transportation, and agrees to be responsible for any necessary maintenance for Silverline at its sole cost and expense during the term of the Agreement; and

**WHEREAS,** Henderson will establish new right-of-way access to provide for connectivity within the Eldorado Valley prior to the expiration of the Agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that City Council approves the agreement to provide for dedication of public rights-of-way and delineating roadway improvement and maintenance responsibilities for rights-of-way along existing Roadway commonly known as Silverline Road; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that City Council authorizes the appropriate staff members

to execute the agreement.
