Overview:

- The City Council approved using \$400,000 in ARPA funds to support the Boulder City Hospital to hire a Community Resource Liaison
- The Boulder City Hospital hired Jennifer Hedland
- Ms. Hedland will report out to the City Council on how she has supported the needs of local residents

Background Information:

The City Council approved the use of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Funds to support the creation of a Community Resource Liaison position at the Boulder City Hospital. Jennifer Hedland was hired to serve in that role. For the past two years, Ms. Hedland has been working closely with the City's Fire and Police Departments to address the needs of local residents. She is connected to both local and regional resources that have helped residents with housing, employment and senior citizen care.

Ms. Hedland has prepared a presentation to summarize her efforts in the community over the past two years and to answer City Council questions.
