For possible action: Resolution No. 7968, a resolution of the City Council of Boulder City, Nevada, approving Agreement No. 25-029 (Interlocal Contract 3219) between the City of Boulder City and the Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada to provide construction funding in the amount of \$3,000,000.00 for the Arterial Reconstruction Program 2020-21, B.C. Project No. 20-1114-STR, and reallocate both the funding and expenditures of the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 capital budget

Business Impact Statement:

This action will not have a significant economic impact on business and will not directly restrict the formation, operation, or expansion of a business.

Action Requested:

That the City Council approve the resolution, approving the agreement (Interlocal Contract 3219) between the City of Boulder City and the Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada to provide construction funding in the amount of \$3,000,000.00 for the Arterial Reconstruction Program 2020-21, B.C. Project No. 20-1114-STR, and reallocate both the funding and expenditures of the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 capital budget.

Overview:

•The RTC is providing the City with construction funding for the Arterial Reconstruction Program for the reconstruction of Nevada Way from the intersection of Wyoming Street to the south side of the intersection of Colorado Street.

- This project will consist of removal and replacement of existing improvements, pulverizing the existing asphalt and base material, base preparation, paving, construction of new curb and gutter, sidewalk, access ramps, medians with tree wells, crosswalks with pavers, and festive gates with LED lighting.
- The Arterial Reconstruction project on Nevada Way helps improve the efficiency and effectiveness of the City's transportation system.

Background Information:

The Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada (RTC) previously provided the City with funding for the design of the Arterial Reconstruction Program 2020-21 and is now providing the City with funding for the construction of the project. This project will consist of the reconstruction on Nevada Way from the intersection of Wyoming Street to the south side of the intersection of Colorado Street. Work will also include removal and replacement of existing improvements including concrete bump-outs, streetscape trees, cross gutters, medians, driveways, artwork, streetlights, bollards, signage, and street furniture. Work will also include surveying, pulverizing the existing asphalt and base material, base preparation, paving, construction of new curb and gutter, sidewalk, access ramps, medians with tree wells, crosswalks with pavers, and festive gates with LED lighting.

Per the terms of the agreements, the City is responsible for the design, inspection, construction, or contract administration of this project utilizing either City staff or consultants contracted by the City. The City will be responsible for maintaining the facilities to protect the improvements at its cost. The project is to be completed to the satisfaction of the RTC prior to the applicable completion date of June 30, 2030. If it becomes necessary to request an increase in provided funding, a written request shall be made to the RTC and a supplement to the agreement may then be executed.
