For possible action: Resolution No. 7842, a resolution of the City Council of Boulder City, Nevada, awarding a bid to American Pavement Preservation, LLC in the amount not to exceed \$1,518,247.09 for the Pavement Preservation FY2024 – Slurry Seal, B.C. Project No. 22-1144-STR

## Business Impact Statement:

This action will not have a significant economic impact on business and will not directly restrict the formation, operation, or expansion of a business.

## Action Requested:

That the City Council approve the resolution awarding a bid to American Pavement Preservation, LLC in the amount not to exceed \$1,518,247.09 for the Pavement Preservation FY2024 – Slurry Seal, B.C. Project No. 22-1144-STR.

## Overview:

- June 27, 2024, a Notice Inviting Bids was advertised for the project.
- July 25, 2024, 1 bid was received, opened, and tabulated.
- The Bid Summary has been attached for reference.
- American Pavement Preservation, LLC was the sole bidder, with a bid of \$1,518,247.09.
- Funding source for this project is from the RTC.

## Background Information:

After reviewing open funding contracts with the Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada (RTC) and determining the project status for each, Public Works staff identified eight contracts with remaining funding that could be reallocated to the

much needed city-wide pavement preservation efforts. The RTC is providing the City with funding for the Pavement Preservation FY2024 project in the amount of \$4,000,000.00. This portion of the project will consist of slurry seal on various city streets for an estimated amount of 329,930 square yards.

The Notice Inviting Bids for this project was posted to the Nevada Government eMarketplace (NGEM) on June 27, 2024. On July 25, 2024, 1 bid was received, opened, and tabulated. The Bid Summary showing the bidder’s information and bid amounts has been included as an attachment to this staff report. American Pavement Preservation, LLC was the sole bidder, with a bid of \$1,518,247.09. Once the Notice to Proceed is issued, this will be a 90-calendar day project.
