RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BOULDER CITY, NEVADA, APPROVING AGREEMENT NO. 24-2107 BETWEEN THE CITY OF BOULDER CITY AND AMERICAN PUBLIC POWER ASSOCIATION TO ENTER INTO A MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT FOR ELECTRIC SERVICES SUPPORT

WHEREAS, the City of Boulder City strives to maintain operational excellence and enhance the reliability and resiliency of its electric utility services; and

WHEREAS, during the City's Reliable Public Power Provider (RP3) application process, it was identified that participation in a national mutual aid agreement is an industry standard best practice for public power utilities; and

WHEREAS, Boulder City's Fire Department has mutual aid agreements in place to provide critical first responder support during emergencies, locally, and nationwide; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to include the Electric Division in similar power restoration efforts, enabling it to both provide and receive electric services support during emergencies in collaboration with other public power utilities nationwide; and

WHEREAS, the American Public Power Association (APPA) has offered a mutual aid agreement that allows Boulder City's Electric Division to formally participate in a nationwide network of public power utilities to provide and receive assistance as needed; and

WHEREAS, entering into this agreement will enhance the City's capacity for rapid power restoration efforts and further strengthen its position as a leader in public utility services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council approves Agreement No. 24-2107 between the City of Boulder City and American Public Power Association to enter into a Mutual Aid Agreement for Electric Services Support
