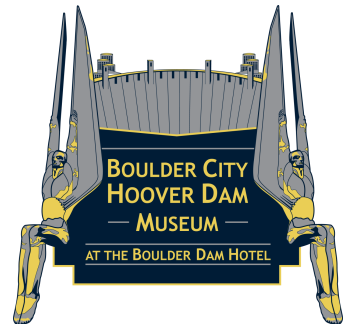


# Updates by John Calvert, Board Chair

- We welcomed new tenants to our restaurant space, Restaurant 1933.

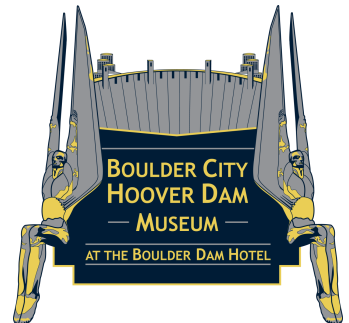

Contributions by State





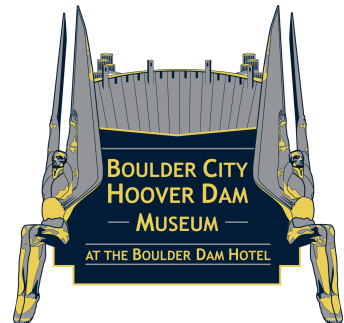
# Window Restoration at 640 Avenue C



May 2024

With the cities of Las Vegas and Boulder City, and through a grant from the Nevada State Historic Preservation Office, we hosted a workshop on the cost-effective restoration & weatherization of historic, double-hung, wood windows.

The workshop restored four of the original wood windows at the museum's property at 640 Avenue C. We expect to complete the window restorations in 2025.

## Google Ads

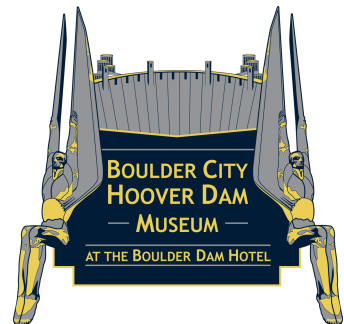
- 7,505 people sought directions to historic downtown through our Google Ads grant

## WalkBC

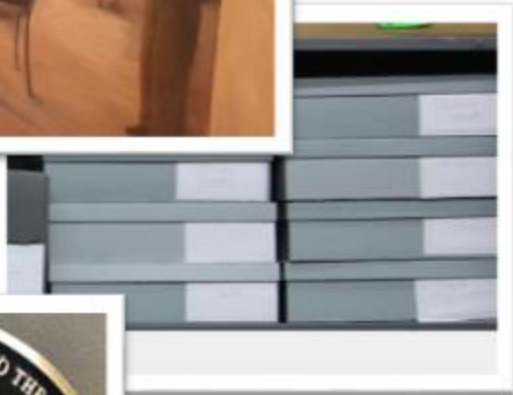
- 4,130 people used WalkBC, our self-guided, audio walking tour
