- **STEM Guitar Project** – We support our middle and high school students in building a personalized guitar start to finish.
- **Hensel Ethics Essay Contest** – We participate in this essay contest for high school students that was started by Rotarian George Hensel. Students include their views of ethics in their essays, which are judged at the club and district level.
- **District Corazon Superbuild** – We travel to areas outside of the United States to help build homes in communities for individuals in need.
- **Friends of the Desert** – We partner with a local Henderson organization which provides meals to the homeless located at St. Timothy's Episcopal Church.
- **Safety Officer Award Recognition** – We support the Southern Nevada Rotary Clubs in honoring First Responders from all branches each year for going above and beyond the line of duty.
- **Miracle League** – We partner with the Miracle League of Las Vegas is providing an all-star baseball experience to special needs children and adults.
- **Boulder City High Senior BBQ** – We support the BCHS Senior BBQ each year with donation of food product and volunteers
