

RESOLUTION NO. 7957

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BOULDER CITY, NEVADA, ACCEPTING A \$2,500 GRANT FROM THE SOUTHERN NEVADA CHAPTER OF THE INTERNATIONAL CODE COUNCIL (SN-ICC) TO PROVIDE FREE SWIMMING LESSONS TO TODDLERS 4 YEARS OF AGE AND YOUNGER AND AMENDING THE FY 2025 BUDGET FOR REVENUES AND EXPENSES

WHEREAS, the Southern Nevada Chapter of International Code Council (SN-ICC) would like to reduce the number of toddler drowning deaths in Nevada; and

WHEREAS, from 2019-2023, Southern Nevada has lost 36 children in drowning deaths; and

WHEREAS, the SN-ICC recently approved a grant of \$2,500 to each jurisdiction in Southern Nevada that is a member of the Southern Nevada Building Officials; and

WHEREAS, the funds must be used to provide free swim lessons to toddlers 4 years of age and younger; if there is an insufficient number of such toddlers to expend the entire \$2,500, then funds can be used to provide free swim lessons to children of any age.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that City Council accept a \$2,500 grant from the SN-ICC to provide free swimming lessons to toddlers 4 years of age and younger at the Boulder City Pool and amend the FY 2025 budget for revenues and expenses; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the appropriate staff is hereby authorized to accept and appropriate the grant funds on behalf of the City of Boulder City.
