Action Requested:

(IRP)

That the Utility Advisory Committee consider the presentation of the draft Electric 2023 - 2027 Integrated Resource Plan.

Overview:

• Integrated resource planning (IRP) is a planning process for new energy resources that evaluates alternatives such as power purchase agreements and energy efficiency programs.

• As a recipient of federal hydro-power, Boulder City must comply with the requirements of 10 CFR Part 905, including preparation of a five-year IRP conforming to requirements established by the Western Area Power Administration (WAPA), public participation in the IRP process, and submittal of annual IRP updates to WAPA.

• Public comments to this presentation and Staff responses will be added to the IRP document and posted to the City's website by December 22, 2022.

• Staff will request that Council approve the final electric 2023 – 2027 IRP at the January 10, 2023 regular public meeting.
