

RESOLUTION NO. 7590

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BOULDER CITY, NEVADA, REALLOCATING AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$70,000 FROM PPE AND VACCINE PURPOSES AND TO BE REALLOCATED TO THE BOULDER CITY MUSEUM AND HISTORICAL ASSOCIATION FOR RECORD DIGITIZATION AND HISTORICAL RESOURCE REHABILITATION

WHEREAS, the City of Boulder City ("City") has received federal dollars from the American Rescue Plan Act to mitigate the effects of the COVID-19 Pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the City had allocated funding towards purchasing personal protective equipment and the deployment of vaccines and covid testing kits under Resolution No. 7481; and

WHEREAS, the Pandemic is now over and the City has unspent funds for those two activities that can be reallocated towards other eligible activities; and

WHEREAS, the Boulder City Museum and Historical Association ("Museum") has requested funding to assist them in their efforts to digitize their collections and to rehabilitate a historic home located at 640 Avenue C to retain its historical fabric in the total amount of \$70,000; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to reallocate the funding previously designated for PPE and Vaccines to the Museum for their historical preservation efforts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council reallocates \$70,000 in American Rescue Plan Act funding previously designated for PPE purchase and the deployment of vaccines and Covid 19 test kits to the Boulder City Museum and Historical Association for purposes of digitizing their historical resource collection and the rehabilitation of a historic resource located at 640 Avenue C.
