For possible action: Resolution No. 7592, a resolution of the City Council of Boulder City, Nevada, awarding a bid to Acme Underground Inc., in the amount not to exceed \$328,682.50 for the Water Service Replacements – Georgia South, B.C. Project No. 22-1157-WD

Business Impact Statement:

This action will not have a significant economic impact on business and will not directly restrict the formation, operation, or expansion of a business

Action Requested:

That the City Council approve the resolution awarding a bid to Acme Underground Inc., in the amount not to exceed \$328,682.50 for the Water Service Replacements – Georgia South, B.C. Project No. 22-1157-WD.

Overview:

- February 2, 2023 a Notice Inviting Bids was advertised for the project.
- February 16, 2023, 4 bids were received, opened, and tabulated.
- The Bid Summary has been attached for reference.
- Acme Underground Inc. was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, with a bid of \$328,682.50.
- Funding source for this project is from the Water Utility Fund and is eligible for reimbursement from the American Rescue Plan Act.

Background Information:

Each year, the Public Works Department replaces aging and failing plastic water service lines in Boulder City with new copper services. Plastic water service lines installed in the past have a short life span,

causing water to be wasted and damage to streets from leaks. Copper service lines have a long and reliable history of use for water service lines. There are 51 service replacements included in the Water Service Replacements – Georgia South project.

The Notice Inviting Bids for this project was posted to the Nevada Government eMarketpace (NGEM) on February 2, 2023. On February 16, 2023, 4 bids were received, opened, and tabulated. The Bid Summary showing the bidder's information and bid amounts has been included as an attachment to this staff report. Acme Underground Inc. was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, with a bid of \$328,682.50. Once the Notice to Proceed is issued, this will be a 120-calendar day project.
